Founded in 2009, the company was developed through the i³ Idea Challenge put on by the W. Brett Wilson Centre for Entrepreneurial Excellence. 3twenty took first place in the competition.

In May 2010, the team of Evan Willoughby, Channing McCorrison, and Bryan McCrea, travelled to Toronto with their 4000-pound modular demo office, and pitched their idea on CBC's "Dragons' Den." They were successful in 'containing' W. Brett Wilson, and struck a deal with him on air.
